STAFFING UPDATES:

Custodians: Our beloved Sharon Gordon will be taking a well-deserved retirement in April. Her last day is April 16th. We sure are going to miss having her around SKC hallways!

SKC HOME AND SCHOOL:

All parents/guardians are welcome! We encourage new membership, and it is never too late to join/attend meetings. Our next meeting date will be in March 18th at 6pm in the school staff room. This might be the last meeting of the school year depending on committee schedules.

We are planning a "SKC Swing into Spring Auction" on Facebook from April 12-19th. All proceeds going towards school needs. Details to come at a later date.

Home & School will be purchasing a yearbook for each grade 8 student as a closing gift. Home & School is also sponsoring the ice rental and bus costs for the school skate on March 15th.

PHYS ED UPDATES:

Ball hockey intramurals will continue until approximately May at recess on Days 2, 4 and 6.

Badminton club started on Jan 24th. Grade 5-6 students play after school on Wednesdays. Gr 7-8 students play after school on Mondays. Pickup is at 3:30pm. The club will last until the end

of February. In March, we will rollover into badminton tryouts after school with the same schedule as the club.

Mr. Bell started a snowshoe/cross-country ski club for interested students in Gr 5-8. The first day will be Feb 27th. Students must return permission forms, as we have a limited number of equipment. Students must come prepared with winter boots (not Blundstones), heavy socks, snow pants, winter coat, and gloves. We hope to run this group every Thursday until the snow is gone. We will not be able to start on Feb 29th, as Mr. Bell needs to attend a PD day. There will be no club on Thu, Mar 7th due to parent teacher interviews. We hope to have the club after school on both March 14th and 21st. If we add in an extra day before the break, we will notify the group.

MUSIC UPDATES:

Parents are not required to go to the rink; we will have staff and leadership students helping tie skates. Please ensure skates/helmets are labeled, and students are dressed appropriately.

For those students who do not want to skate, gym activities will be planned at the school. Students who are not skating will not be going to the rink.
